#### History: Presbyterian Church of EVL

**Rooted from Congregationalist Minister**

The first Presbyterian services in Ellicottville were held in 1818 in the home of Orrin Pitcher on Bryant Hill Road who moved from Great Valley where the first services were first held in his home for three years. Photo/Jay Karassik

According to the history of Cattaraugus County, a westward migration of settlers from Scotland and other parts of Europe who first migrated to New Jersey, Pennsylvania and the Carolinas took place after the Revolutionary War ended in 1783. Although the Continental pronounced Congress colonies free and independent states on July 4, 1776, the war continued for seven more years. Well before The Manifest Destiny far into the future in the 1840's, settlers on the coast in those early 1800's, post war years had seen their future in the West. The western lands, they believed, could be tamed, cleared and farmed. And so,
