Construction of the new lift will take place in summer 2023 and it will be ready for passengers by November of 2023.

With an eye on the future, Holiday Valley Resort in Ellicottville, NY is planning construction for a 6 passenger chairlift starting in the summer of 2022, with completion of the lift in September 2023. The

new lift will replace the Mardi Gras Express, a 4 passenger high speed lift built in 1996 that runs up through the heart of the resort
