AASM's Erin Flynn-Evans, says it's time to end it permanently, "Research shows that time changes affect the body's circadian rhythm, or body clock, which makes it more difficult to achieve quality sleep and also negatively impacts health and safety."

The AASM is strongly against the Senate bill, and keep Standard Time in place all year round. In a position statement, endorsed by more than 20 medical, scientific, and civic organizations, including the American College of Chest Physicians, National PTA, National Safety Council, Society for Research on Biological Rhythms, and World Sleep Society, the AASM says, "Current evidence best supports the adoption of year-round standard time, which aligns best with human circadian biology and provides distinct benefits for public health and safety."

Either way, you have to wait a little longer. Congress simply must decide to keep DST or ST, and yes, on that point, only time will tell.
