

Remembering Hurricane Agnes

Hurricane Hit Our Region 50 Years Ago, This Month

Hurricane Agnes in 1972 was the costliest hurricane to hit the United States at the time, causing an estimated \$2.1 billion in damage. The storm formed on June 14 and dissipated on July 6, 1972. The hurricane's death toll was 128. The effects of Agnes were widespread, from the Caribbean to Canada, with much of the east coast of the United States affected. Damage was heaviest in Pennsylvania, where Agnes was the state's wettest tropical cyclone. Due to the significant effects, the name Agnes was retired in the spring of 1973. – Wikipedia.com (See story, "HURRICANE", Page 9.)
