



The Pan-American Expo was a World's Fair held in Buffalo May 1-Nov. 2, 1901. The fair occupied 350 acres of land on the western edge of what is now Delaware Park, extending from Delaware Ave. to Elmwood Ave. and northward to Great Arrow Ave. Although most buildings of the Expo were torn down, the New York State Building (pictured) in Delaware Park survived and is now used as a museum by the Buffalo History Museum. (See "SEPTEMBER", page 12.)
