Windmills are made with fiberglass, steel, and plastic that are so durable that it is almost completely unable to break down. They also have the tendency to negatively impact wildlife and agriculture. Not being able to recycle such large and consistent materials adds to the waste we are trying to control. Recycling is a key factor in limiting the amount of virgin products we are required to make that produce the greenhouse gas and fossil fuel emissions we are trying to avoid.
