A staunch suffragette, Walker wore men's clothing and frequently argued for women's rights. She was given the Medal of Honor -America's highest personal *military decoration — by* **President Andrew Johnson** in 1865. Walker's medal was taken away from her and 910 others in 1917 when the U.S. Army reviewed their merit. The government believed her civilian status made her ineligible. She died in 1919. The Department of the Army restored her medal posthumously in 1977.
