Born into a family of eight children in England, Austen started writing her now classic novels, such as Pride and Prejudice and Sense and Sensibility, in her teens. Her novels are funny, endearing, and questioned women's roles within society. Austen had to hide her identity as the author of some of the most popular novels of her day and it wasn't until her death that her brother, Henry, revealed to the public that she was the real author.
