The Roycroft Inn

Artisan Beauty in East Aurora





The Roycroft Campus in East Aurora is steeped in history. Visitors are offered a glimpse at the Roycroft way of life and its story as it began in 1897. Elbert Hubbard, legendary man of vision, founded the American Arts and Crafts Movement in East Aurora, NY. In 1905 the Roycroft Inn was opened to accommodate visitors and artisans looking to experience this emerging community and style. The Inn became a center of activity for this community. In 1986, The Roycroft Inn, as part of the Roycroft Campus, received National Historic Landmark status.

The Roycroft Inn and Campus is arguably one of the bestpreserved complex of buildings devoted to craftsmanship and philosophy in the United States.

During the late 19th century, this 'guild' community was and remains centered around The Roycroft way of life: learning, trade, and enrichment.
