Oakley developed hunting skills as a child to provide for her impoverished family in western Ohio. At age 15, she won a shooting contest against an experienced marksman, Frank E. Butler, whom she married in 1876. The pair joined Buffalo Bill in 1885, performing in Europe before royalty and other heads of state. Audiences were astounded to see her shooting out a cigar from her husband's hand or splitting a playing-card edge-on at 30 paces. She earned more than anyone except Buffalo Bill himself. She also instructed in women marksmanship, believing strongly in female self-defense. Her stage acts were filmed for one of Thomas Annie Oakley (born Phoebe Ann Edison's earliest Kinetoscopes in 1894. Since her death, her story
