St. Paul's first occupied a church building on Beaver Hollow Road and Route 219 from 1923 and was known as St. Peter's Lutheran Church. The congregation then moved to a building at the corner of Elizabeth and Mechanic Street and was renamed St. Paul's (now a residence, complete with cupola) celebrating their twenty-fifth anniversary in 1948 at that location. The original 1923 church building fell into disrepair and accidentally burned to the ground in the early 60's while privately owned. In 1964, St. Paul's moved to its present location at 6360 Route 242 in Ellicottville. This year, they have been celebrating their 100th anniversary.
