





The Kandahar Race

From 1878 - 1880 coinciding with the era imperial conquest, the British were mired in a grinding war in Afghanistan that they titled "The Second Afghan War." British forces were besieged in the Afghan city of Kandahar. The British sent Field Marshall Earl Roberts to save the British soldiers. He marched over 300 miles across an inhospitable Afghanistan with 10,000 troops, and on September 1,1880, defeated the Afghanis at the Battle of Kandahar and lifted the siege. If you fail to provide the document, in recordable form, cancelling the lease within the time specified, the lease will be terminated pursuant to the provisions of General Obligations Law § 15-304.

If You Believe the Lease Remains In Effect: If you believe that the lease referenced above has not terminated, you must file an affidavit to that effect in Oswego County within thirty (30) days of your receipt of this Demand and Notice and must provide a copy of such affidavit to the Person Giving Notice within ten (10) days following the filing of such affidavit.




