firing processes - wood firing, traditional Japanese Raku firing, and contemporary electric kiln firing - used for distinct 'product lines' of ceramics.

Her displays include fairy houses - small clay cottages with fairies perched on the roof - footed bowls that feel like the lower half of huge ceramic


