Bridge Construction Safety Netting Lowers Clearance



The safety netting has lowered the clearance under the bridge by nearly 5 ½ feet. A sailboat that once had six feet of room under the bridge at flood level, now has less than one. And it will take some brilliant and daring seamanship to get from one side to the other until that clearance is lifted, which, according to New York State, won't happen until the bridge is completed, a two-to-threeyear period if every single thing goes according to plan.


