Fighting For, Honoring & Celebrating Our Freedoms



July 4th is a celebration of the 13 American colonies declaring they were free of British rule. Those colonies were: New Hampshire, Massachusetts, Connecticut, Rhode Island, New York, New Jersey, Pennsylvania, Delaware, Maryland, Virginia, North Carolina, South Carolina, and Georgia. That first American flag consisted of 13 stripes and 13 stars in a circle on a blue field. Imagine being those colonists seeing that flag flying for the first time, signaling their rebirth as American citzens. Now, that was certainly reason to celebrate. (Story, "JULY" pg. 5.)
