The Fredonia Opera House just celebrated its 30th year since the restoration, and has been operating year-round since November 1994, presenting around 105 performances annually. In order to best meet the needs of the community, it became necessary to replace the small, uncomfortable seats. ### Mark Your Calendar: Valentine's Day, February 14

#### **Dedicated Day to Express Your Appreciation**



The first printed cards adorned with paper flowers or frill on record date from 1797, but by the mid 19th century, an enterprising young 20-year-old, Esther Howland, whose family owned a stationery store thought she could do bet-ter by offering hand-made cards much like she had seen made in England. Covered with adornments and lace she created these cards and sold them for seventy-five cents (now \$100.) Price seemed inconsequential as she was swamped with orders and had to hire help to fill them all. Her business eventually became the successful New England Valentine Company. "Named the "Mother of the American Valentine" in a newspaper after her death in 1904, Howland's enduring claim to fame lies not only in having produced the first elaborate, handcrafted valentines in the United States, but also in having popularized Valentine's Day cards across the country.
