Kind of sounds like the beginning of a Hallmark Valentine movie! Just picture them, in aprons and caps, in that circa 1900's kitchen stirring copper pots of Karo syrup and sugar and then adding the secret ingredients made their goooey syrup into SPONGE CANDY!

Haven't you ever wondered how they get that stuff to puff with all those holes (like a sponge) in it? What's so amazing is that they made these candies in small batches and quickly put the fresh product on the shelves in their shop to sell, batch by batch.
