





Having grown up in the Buffalo area, casual drives into the higher-class areas provided us with many opportunities to ooh and ahhh, as we could only imagine what the inside of these ornate buildings looked like. It is only through current research that I find I attended high school (Villa Maria) on the grounds of what used to belong to the fabulous Urban estate, not realizing what was just up the road from our beautiful and spacious campus.

Until May 18, you are invited to ooh and ahhhover the 2025 featured home -George Urban Mansion, located at 280 Pine Ridge Cheektowaga, Road, which stands as an historic landmark on the remaining 1.4 acre lot reflecting the industrial and architectural legacy of Buffalo and Western New York (much of its original land was subsequently sold for subdivisions and for Cheektowaga Town Park, along with the land the Felician nuns bought for their residence and school in 1920).
